School lunch money reminder: it is important that you keep a note of how much money is on your child's school lunch account (WisePay - My Wise Account), as we are unable to supply your child with a school meal without payment being available on meal accounts. Please bear in mind that payment is not instant and can take a few days to reach the Thomas Coram account.

All children in Key Stage 1 now receive Free School Meals automatically. If you think your child, in Key Stage 2, may be entitled to Free School Meals, please apply online at www.hertsdirect.org/freeschoolmeals for a quick and easy confirmation of eligibility. Alternatively you may ring 0300 123 4048 between 8.00am and 8.00pm Monday to Friday or between 9.00am and 4.00pm Saturday.



If you don't play a keyboard instrument, come anyway and discover for yourself how the different keys and stops combine to make the huge variety of sounds that the organ can make.
