[Thursday 3 March is World Book Day](#). As part of our preparations, we are setting a challenge for pupils over the February half term: Where is the most unusual place you have ever read a book? Over the half term holiday, we would like pupils to have their photograph taken reading in an unusual place; it could be in this country or overseas; inside or outside. They might be reading a book, a poster, a comic or a leaflet. We would like to use the photographs to create a display for World Book Day; so after half term, please bring the photograph in an envelope with your child's name and class on.

After half term pupils will be playing [football in their Game-on PE lessons](#). Pupils will need warm outdoor PE kit and suitable shoes for the muddy conditions. Football boots, although not essential, may be worn.
