**Thursday 3 March is World Book Day.** World Book Day (Thursday 3 March) celebrates the joy of books and reading, especially for children. Thank you to all of you who sent in photos of your child reading in an unusual place. A display for the main entrance hall is underway. On March 3, every child will be receiving a £1 World Book Day Token that can either be exchanged for one of ten special £1 World Book Day books or used to get £1 off any book costing £2.99 or more. 5. On the next screen enter the words/numbers or phrase in the 'Security Check' page
6. Continue to checkout, enter payment details and finalise order\*
