Dear Parents/Carers

As we come to the end of this academic year, the decision has been taken to review the Year 4 classes. This is partially due to an imbalance in the number of pupils in each class as a result of leavers and new entrants over the year, but is also in line with the precedent, which was set last year, to mix up the classes as the pupils move into the upper half of the school.

Year 4 teachers have spoken to the pupils and asked them to identify who they work well with. These choices have been taken into consideration, alongside our professional judgement and knowledge of the pupils when putting the new classes together.

A number of pupils have also expressed concerns about the move up into Upper Key Stage 2. To this end, we have arranged for current Year 5 pupils to talk to Year 4 about their experiences this year in order to reassure them and allay any concerns.

Current Year 3, 4 and 5 pupils will be meeting their new class teachers early next week as part of our internal transition process.
