Key Stage 2 national curriculum statutory test results 2017

Year 6 children and parents received their individual results with their report last week but I wanted us all to have an opportunity to congratulate them, and their current and past teachers, on their fantastic achievements.

The percentage of pupils achieving the expected standard is shown below with national and Hertfordshire provisional data. This is followed by the percentage of pupils achieving the higher standard.
