Notices and reminders

This week our whole school worships have been led by Mrs Cutler and Father Simon. Continuing with the value of Responsibility, we have been reflecting on the importance of using our time wisely, thinking about what we can achieve during a day. This was illustrated through the story of the Ant and the Grasshopper which is familiar to many of the children. In particular, the children thought about how they could give a 'gift of time' to someone, perhaps helping a younger sibling or a parent or carer. As it is half term next week, we hope that everyone has the opportunity to relax and recharge and we look forward to welcoming the children back on Monday 5 November.

As the darker evenings are approaching, can we ask parents and carers of children in Years 5 & 6 to remind them about crossing the road safely, namely find a safe place to cross the road and remind them about parked cars. Children in Year 5 received pedestrian skills training at the end of the Year 4 and Year 6 pupils were trained whilst at Hazard Alley last year. It is also worth noting that many road traffic incidents occur as a result of people being distracted by mobile devices or wearing headphones.
